

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSBURG, KENTUCKY DECLARING  
CERTAIN SIDEWALKS TO BE A PUBLIC WAY

Whereas, KRS 82.400 provides that when any property has been opened to unrestricted use for five consecutive years it shall be conclusively presumed to have been dedicated to the city or consolidated local government as a public way or easement subject to acceptance by the city or consolidated local government; and,

Whereas, those sidewalks located in the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky adjacent to Cardinal Drive and College Court have been opened to the unrestricted use to the general public for five (5) consecutive years; and,

Whereas, the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky wishes to accept the dedication thereof pursuant to statute.


Now therefore, the counsel of the city of Campbellsburg, Kentucky has determined that sidewalks adjacent to and parallel with Cardinal Drive and College Court in the City of Campbellsburg have been opened to the unrestricted use of the general public for five (5) consecutive years.

That the acceptance of the dedication of said sidewalks to the city is beneficial to and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky.


That the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky does hereby pursuant to KRS 82.400, accept dedication of said sidewalks (public ways) to the city. Provided, however, acceptance hereof shall in no way be a defense to collection of any tax that may be levied against the property abutting thereon.

Further, the responsibility for maintenance of said sidewalk in all respects shall remain with the owner of the property over which said sidewalk crosses. Provided, the City may, in its sole discretion choose to participate in such maintenance if it sees fit.
