

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-02

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING OPEN BURNING IN THE CITY OF
CAMPBELLSBURG, KENTUCKY**

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CAMPBELLSBURG, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

A. No person shall cause, suffer or allow any open burning within the city limits of the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky without a burning permit issued by the city. Open burning is limited to yard debris only.

B. Any person seeking permission from the city for open burning shall do so in writing on an application form provided by the city. The application form shall include the following information: Name and address of applicant, phone number of applicant, address of proposed burn, itemization of materials proposed to be burned, date of burn and such other information as the city may reasonably require. The form will be completed by the applicant and reviewed by the Campbellsburg Volunteer Fire Department (CVFD) Fire Chief or his representative. Based on quantities of material to be burned, environmental conditions, and other factors for consideration, the Fire Chief will or will not provide an endorsement. If the endorsement to burn is received, the requestor shall file the application form at City Hall prior to burning. If City Hall is closed, forms may be left in the drop slot near the front door.

C. Excepted herefrom and permitted is a controlled fire which is not open and which is contained completely within a metal/brick/cinder block/stone container with sufficient grate or other protection so as not to permit floating debris or excessive smoke. The burning of any material other than yard debris is prohibited.

D. It is the responsibility of the applicant to abide by the provisions of this ordinance and the guidance of the Fire Chief. The applicant is solely liable for control and safety of the authorized burn to include minimizing any nuisance to neighbors.


E. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense.

F. All prior ordinances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith be and hereby are specifically repealed.


